Greetings of our Honor:

Thank you for your consideration here:
I am writing to inquire about the docket status of my Petition supra. Just yesterday, the S.B.C.D.C. returned the envelopes and 100 postage stamps which my legal assistant had mailed to me. These items are considered "contraband" by Detention Center staff. Why?

Without those stamps or envelopes, I will be forced to wait more than a week to order same from the Commissary; and, all such arbitrary delays are only aggravating the oppression, and retaliation, I am being coerced to endure.

On the merits, my legal assistant has now assembled a partial set of the pleadings I have already written, and filed,

on my own behalf, In Propria Persona, in the U.S. District Court in Cheyenne. As soon as I can acquire more stamps, please accept my promise to mail to my assistant a written request that he forward those pleadings to the Clerk of your Court, as soon as possible.

In the alternative, attorney Mark Hardee, in Cheyenne, should also have a full set of pleadings, but the Federal docket in that case is "SEALED" for reasons never disclosed to me: #2:14-CR-00027-NDF-2.

More tortious interference was revealed to me yesterday in my assistant's letter, which summarized my Seattle landlord's intent to rene my private apartment to a different tenant: I have been using that apartment to conduct computer research to support a utility patent application which I now have pending at the U.S. Patent Office, Wash, D.C.

In conclusion, please direct the Clerk of your Court to notify me in writing of the Docket Number assigned to my Petition supra: People v. Harris et al.
